Distances:

junior DEF division B: 500m and SF 500m junior DEF division A: 500m and SF 777m Junior ABC/SM: 500m and SF 1000m

The organizing committee chooses to organize as much StarClass distances as possible for skaters as an opportunity to ride qualifying times.

Relays:

If permitted by the time schedule, relays will be organized. Relay teams can participate in every composition of gender. Each team needs 4 skaters, teams of 3 skaters are not allowed. Mixing of clubs/countries is allowed. Skaters in the following categories can make a team:

EF 2000m
CD 2000m
ABSM 3000m



Entry:

Through the relevant club's competition secretary via www.shorttrackonline.info.

Closing entry: Sunday november 26th 2023

Relay teams must enter before this same date by email: youth.yds.hasselt@gmail.com

Relay teams that doesn't inscribe by email, will **not** be entered on the day of the competition.

Division and category:

skaters with a Belgian, Dutch or Luxembourg Licence.

Dutch skaters must be members of a club from the Region NBLZ.

Junior F, born after 01-07-2014

Junior E, born between 01-07-2012 and 30-06-2014

Junior D, born between 01-07-2010 and 30-06-2012

Junior C, born between 01-07-2008 and 30-06-2010

Junior A, B, and S/M born before 01-07-2008

Helmet caps:

All skaters need to have helmet caps.

The caps will be handed out to the team leader. At the end of the competition the helpdesk will be open to return the helmet caps.

A deposit of €10,00/cap or a total of €50,00 per club will be charged at the registration desk.

Registration fee:

€30 per skater needs to be paid <u>in cash</u> by the team leader at the registration desk before the start of the competition. It is not possible to pay by card (or "pinnen")

Safety:

All skaters must wear cut-resistant accessories such as hand gloves, shin and knee protectors, neck protector and a short track helmet.

Prices:

There will be an overall stage for the first 3 skaters in each age category for the individual races: F-E-D-C-B-A

Seniors and Masters will be kept together at the overall ranking.

Boys and girls, men and women will have an individual stage.

In the categories E and F there will be a participation medal for all skaters.

Prices will only be given to the skaters that are present at the award ceremony.

Prices will not be handed out towards others.

Skaters must enter the award ceremony in their track suit of the club.

When enough skaters enter for Relay, there will be medals for the first 3 teams in each division.
